



How to get here

by Car: From Cancun Airport take the highway 307 towards Tulum for about 1.5 hours be attentive for Oscar y Lalo restaurant keep going for 1 km till you see the sign Mayan Adrenaline ATV's and the Nah Ku sign you will take that road and continue till you find the fish rock 1km in the Jungle. Be attentive for the monkeys.



PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICIES

The following are our policies for payments and cancellation. We understand when organizing a retreat there are many variables to consider and circumstances can change leading to cancellations. These policies are put in place to be fair to both the facilitator and the Nahku Tulum Family.

First Deposit

\$1000 deposit is due upon making the reservation to secure rooms.

This will also serve as Damage Deposit, and will be returned post-event.

If the reservation is canceled more than 150 days prior to the event, the deposit is fully refundable.

If the reservation is canceled less than 150 days days prior to the event, the deposit is non refundable

Second Deposit

Second 25% deposit due 120 days prior to event.

This deposit is non refundable. Rooms held via deposit are the responsibility of the host to fill unless agreed in writing.

Third Deposit

Final 75% is due 15 days prior to event. This deposit is non refundable.
